Thirty-ninth meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance 11–12 February 2026 Bonn, Germany

I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations (NGOs) that the thirty-ninth meeting of the Standing Committee on Finance (SCF 39) will take place from **11 to 12 February 2026**, in Bonn Germany. The SCF will convene a technical expert session to inform the preparation of technical reports of the SCF in 2026 on **11 February 2026**.

Observer nominations should be communicated to the secretariat by constituency focal points. Representatives of admitted NGOs nominated by constituency focal points must register using the online registration form, which will be communicated to the nominated participants. Kindly note that, owing to the limited capacity of the venue, **only two representatives per constituency** will be permitted to participate in person. Constituency focal points are requested to submit their nomination list no later than **Wednesday, 28 January 2026** via cool@unfccc.int.

Additional observers may participate virtually. The deadline for registration for virtual participation through the constituency focal points is **Wednesday, 4 February 2026**.

Further details relevant to both in-person and virtual participation in the meeting will be communicated directly to the registered participants. In view of the need to confirm arrangements for the meeting as early as possible, registrations received after the above-mentioned deadlines may not be processed. The meeting will also be broadcast live for those who cannot be nominated for either one of the two modalities above so that they can follow the meeting. The webcast link will be made available on the SCF web page.
